

What is ?

Skype is a program that allows you to make phone calls over the Internet! Here's the deal:

- From your Skype account, you can contact anyone else with a Skype account for free!
- For a fee, you can use Skype to call any landline or cellular number. This includes international calls!
- You can use SkypeIn to get a phone number for your Skype account – that means friends and family who do not use Skype can call a regular phone number that will “ring” you at your Skype account. SkypeIn comes with a free Skype voicemail account!
- You can also use Skype to do video calling!

Registering for Skype is totally free, but if you want to use SkypeOut or SkypeIn, **you will be required to pay for any and all charges** that you accrue.
