Only approved subscribers of the listserv may post messages to the listserv. Approved subscribers include:

- Student group faculty and staff advisors.

Approved subscribers must send email to lissa@simmons.edu from the email address used to subscribe to the listserv in order to post to the listserv. Only messages from approved subscribers will automatically post to the listserv; all other posts will be held from the listserv.
