Subject Listing of Archives Databases and Other Resources

- Click on the “Resources by Subject” option from the GSLIS Collection Homepage located under the drop-down menus
- Choose “Archives” under the heading “Library Science”

Locating Journals from the Simmons Library

- Search the Simmons Library online catalog under title. All print and electronic journals are included in the online catalog
- If not available at Simmons, search the Fenway Library Consortium online catalogs available as an option on the bottom left of the Simmons College Library online catalog page
- If not available at Simmons or the Fenway Library Consortium Libraries, you may submit an online interlibrary loan request available from the “Services” tab at the top of the homepage.
