## Spanish 101: Multimedia Vocabulary Assessments

### Overview

The PTRC and Marta Villar collaborated to develop reusable interactive multimedia vocabulary self-assessments using the quiz feature of WebCT. The assessments incorporate images and audio files. This allows students to engage the different senses and demonstrate their mastery of the vocabulary associated with a given theme.

The extensive use of audio recordings offers students opportunity to master both vocabulary pronunciation and meaning.

Villar worked closely with the PTRC Instructional Design team to articulate learning goals and design activities, and with the Media Production Specialist to record audio.
